SENIOR RECITAL GUIDELINES

2018-2019

CHOOSING A RECITAL DATE

Vocal Department recital dates have been preselected and included on the Kinder HSPVA school calendar. The last day for you and your recital partner to choose a senior recital date is Friday, December 7, 2018.

RECITAL REPERTOIRE

All senior recital repertoire, accompanists, and additional ensemble members must be approved by the Vocal Department faculty. Ensemble members and accompanists must be able to attend your dress rehearsal.

ACCOMPANIST FEE

One of our Vocal Department Consultants will accompany your Senior Lab masterclass performances and your senior recital. While most accompanists charge between \$45 and \$75 per hour, you will receive approximately 6 hours of professional accompanist services for only \$75. Please note that this fee is included as part of the 2018-19 Vocal Department Fee for seniors.

GUESTBOOK/MEMORY TABLE

A table will be provided near the Recital Hall for recitalists to display photos and other mementos. Many seniors choose to provide a personalized guest book in which attendees can write congratulatory messages. Because food and drink are not permitted in the recital hall, memory displays may not include candy, mints, or other edible treats.

RECEPTIONS

We recognize the importance of celebrating with family and friends following a momentous occasion such as a senior recital. However, due to the many events scheduled in the recital hall, the Vocal Department does not allow on-campus receptions following senior recitals.

LOSING SENIOR RECITAL PRIVILEGE

Seniors will not be allowed to present their recital if any of the following situations occur:

- If the student performer is suspended from school or is assigned in-school suspension at any point during the senior year
- If a senior misses a major concert with his/her ensemble because of a performance with an outside group
- If the student performer does not attend their recital dress rehearsal
- If the student performer is not present at school for the entire school day and does not attend all classes on the day that his/her senior recital is scheduled

SENIOR PROJECT OPTION

A student may choose to do a senior project in lieu of a recital. The Vocal Department faculty must approve the project.
